Achievements and performance

Summary of the main achievements of the charity during the financial period

The Trust has distributed funds of £99,107.00 to a number of local organisations this year.

The main achievements were the ongoing support of our local schools across a number of projects, and the funding of renovation works at the Biggart Hall in Dalry.

The former provides invaluable support to school children where council funding has been withdrawn or is no longer available and the latter ensures that local residents continue to benefit from the use of the hall.

We continue to support the Dalry Cattle Show and have also made a number of awards to organisations who support students and young people.

Funding was also provided to a broad range of local groups to promote welfare, community and the arts.



