primarily intended. 4.1.4 the advancement of education in the community of Ayrshire by promoting, alone or in conjunction with others, football and other sports, literacy, numeracy, life skills, and social activities to a cross section of the community. 4.1.5 the promotion of equality and diversity by encouraging participation in and integration into a range of inclusive and accessible programmes which strive to bring together all sections of the community. 4.1.6 to promote, develop and provide a wider understanding and appreciation of the arts, heritage and culture, particularly in relation to the local area and relative to the local community. 4.1.7 to contribute towards the alleviation of poverty in the local community, working in conjunction with other organisations as appropriate. and 4.1.8 the promotion of such similar charitable purposes, objects or institutions and in such proportions and manner as the Directors shall think fit
