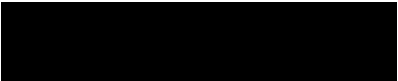
Accounts

Chair of Trustees report to OSCAR on 2024.

2024 saw steady progress in realising our objectives for our charity MacDiarmid,'s Brownsbank in relation to the restoration of Brownsbank Cottage. We were awarded £21630 from the Quarry Trust administered by South Lanarkshire Council and £15000 form the Pilgrims Trust. This enables us to instigate the re-tendering process to establish the contemporary cost of the work to upgrade the building. Thereafter we can apply for the capital costs needed for the restoration.

We also continued to broaden our contact base with much positive input from individuals and organisations supportive of our campaign. At the Biggar Little festival in October we gave a presentation called 'Hugh MacDiarmid and Scotland Now'. This will be given at the Scottish Parliament on 18/03/25.

Following a lean period in the aftermath of the Covid pandemic we are optimistic about continuing progress through 2025.

Independent Examiner's Report to the Committee of the MacDiarmid Brownsbank Trust

I report on the Accounts of the charity for the year ended 31st October 2024 which are set out on the previous page.

Retrospective Responsibilities of Trustees and Examiner

The Charity's Trustees are responsible for the preparation of the Accounts in accordance with the terms of the Charities and Trustees Investment (Scotland) 2005 Act ('the 2005 Act') and the Charities Accounts (Scotland) Regulations 2006 (as amended) ('the 2006 Regulations').

The charity Trustees consider that the audit requirement of Regulation 10 (1) (d) of the 2006 Regulations does not apply. It is my responsibility to examine the Accounts as required under section 44 (1) © of the 2005 Act and to state whether particular matters have come to my attention.

Basis of Independent Examiner's Statement
