### Summary of the main activities in relation to these objects

In the UK – to fundraise through ongoing sponsorship and donations in the UK and overseas, to enable the organisation to support projects, communities and individuals who continue to be affected by the 2015 earthquake and the general lack of infrastructure in Nepal.

In Nepal – to help fund and maintain children's homes in two locations in Nepal; Pokhara and Chitwan and provide a stable base to orphaned, abandoned and displaced children to better access healthcare and education and have a safe environment to live in, free of exploitation.

Due to Covid-19 and changes to government legislation, the children's homes unfortunately had to temporarily close. The children have returned to their villages, where they will be cared for by extended family member or neighbours. We aim to continue to support the education needs of children directly to their homes and villages.



## APPENDIX 1

### Achievements and performance

#### Summary of the main achievements of the charity during the financial period

During the current financial year, we were able to support 20 children in rural Nepal through education and donated £2,550, which covered, 1 years' school fees, backpack, school uniforms, shoes, socks, school tie, school belt, schoolbooks, pencils and school jotters. The children attend Ganganaghar School in Chitwan, Nepal.

I, [REDACTED] (chair) visited Nepal in May 2023 and met the children and their families at school and in their villages. Living is extremely tough in this part of Nepal and our hope is that we can help the children find a way out of poverty through education.

No additional fundraising activities were carried out during the financial period, but plans are in place to further raise awareness of the charity during the coming financial period and to further support projects in Nepal.

Every 2 years we also need to renew our email address and website with Wordpress and our domain names with Go Daddy. In this financial year the cost for this was £497.83. We are actively looking at options to reduce these costs going forward.
