What the charity does: We aim to offer a safe community venue in Hamilton, South Lanarkshire providing event and meeting facilities. Our vision is for our purpose built building to be developed into a space for local community use responding to local need.

Beneficiaries: 'No specific group, or for the benefit of the community', 'Other charities or voluntary bodies'

Objectives: 4.1 to provide recreational facilities and organise recreational facilities with the object of improving the conditions of life for the persons for whom the facilities and activities are primarily intended including, without limitation: 4.1.1 to provide space for the use of St Mary's Episcopal Church Hamilton including for the purposes of Sunday school provision, Messy Church, informal services and social events. 4.1.2 support facilities for families in need and ex-offenders. 4.1.3 provision of space for weekly alcoholic anonymous groups. 4.1.4 café and gathering space for other groups run activities pursuant to the organisation's charitable purposes. and 4.1.5 community events for members of the local community. 4.2 to advance education in partnership with our charitable partners through the provision of a training base at the organisation's facilities. 4.3 to advance community development in partnership with organisations the majority of which are in the voluntary sector by: 4.3.1 encouraging community information to be shared in the space provided by the organisation, in which uniformed organisations and volunteers will be active, and 4.3.2 promoting community groups using the organisation's facilities. 4.4 to advance the arts, heritage and culture with the provision of music, dance, literature and art exhibitions in the organisation's facilities. 4.5 to promote

religious harmony through the support of inter-faith activity which can be developed in the organisation's facilities which has a spiritual aspect. and 4.6 to advance any of the above purposes or objects by the giving of grants or loans or the provision of credit or other forms of assistance, financial or otherwise, to persons undertaking projects, initiatives and/or activities which further any of the above purposes or objects and which are wholly charitable within the meaning of the Taxes Acts and section 7 of the 2005 Act.

Report for St Mary's for All SCIO

The charity trustees are pleased to announce its 9th year annual accounts for St Mary's for All SCIO for the year ended 31st October 2024. The annual report, laid out in pages 5-9, currently based on a receipts and payments basis, presents a summary of our financial activities during the past year.

Funds

St Mary's for All SCIO funds fall into two categories:

1. **Unrestricted** Monies in this category can be spent on any relevant activity and are represented in this report as the General Account.
2. **Restricted** Monies in this category have been received as a result of grant funding and are restricted to being spent for the purposes as determined by the funding body.

Receipts and Payments

Overall receipts of £60,434.51 came from Hall Hire, donations, grant income and contributions towards utilities from St Mary's Episcopal Church. The facilities celebrate its nineth anniversary in November 2024. Payments of £64,871.73 relate to the ongoing running costs of the premises showing a deficit of £4,437.22 over the financial year.

One grant of £15,000 was received from National Lottery. £8,871 of previously received restricted grant income was carried forward from previous years and has been used towards ongoing costs during the accounting year. £11.51 of the restricted grant funds remain unspent at the end of the financial year.

Activities and Achievements

This year has been filled with activity, building on both existing and new community relationships and users. D&M at the Beech Tree cafe continues to provide a valuable service to our weekday users. We are pleased to support other local groups and organisations to reach out and support our community. In particular we are especially pleased that the spaces are used frequently for weekday use allowing us to share our warm welcome with our community.

The SCIO is grateful to the dedicated group of volunteers who continue to man the reception area and assist in day to day enquires and bookings that are received.

Receipts and Payments

Receipts this year were not sufficient to meet Payments incurred throughout the year however this was anticipated as a result of planned expenditure of matters which grant funding had previously been received and carried forward. St Mary's for All relies on the rental from the user groups in order to meet our ongoing running costs. St Mary's for All has been able to continue to meet its financial commitments, through our sustained rental income and additional grant funding. Utility costs are shared between St Mary's for All SCIO and St Mary's Episcopal Church. The continued rising costs of utilities has had an impact on our expenditure during the financial year. The Trustees have continued to take steps this year to cut down on costs where possible and are investing in energy saving projects. We trust that this will have a positive impact on the expenditure going forward.

The trustees would like to thank all those who contribute their time and energy so generously to ensure the continuation and development of St Mary's for All

Independent examiner's statement

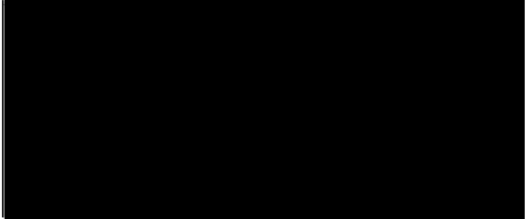
In the course of my examination, no matter has come to my attention:-
