Objectives: The organisations purposes are: 4.1 To advance education by continuing to support the Kunta Kinteh Nursery school in Tallinding, The Gambia, West Africa 4.2 To advance education by continuing to obtain sponsorship for the children of Tallinding and other areas after they leave the nursery and move to a higher level of education. 4.3 To advance education by working towards opening a second school in the future, to offer education to older children 4.4 To advance the public participation in sport by offering the children of Latrikunda, girls and boys, regular coaching and sports sessions with the aim of keeping them off the street and giving the children a hope for the future. 4.5 To offer relief of those in need by offering on going assistance to Lamin health clinic where at the moment we offer help in the form of baby clothes, baby milk, nappies, medication and other relevant supplies to those with financial hardship

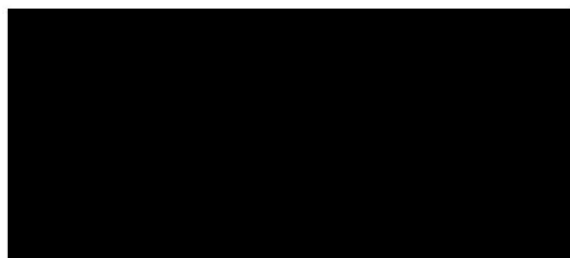

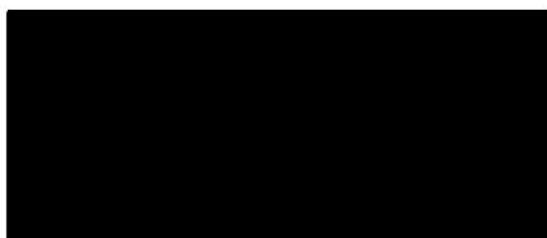

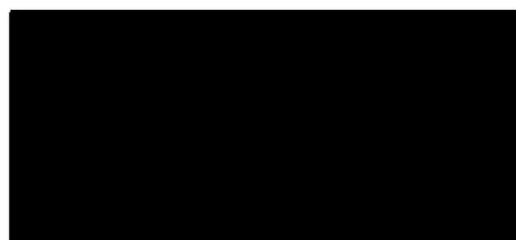

Primary focus for this year remained the continued support of Kunta Kinteh nursery and primary schools in Tallinding, Gambia. Monies raised through our school sponsorship program with 119 participants as described in the supporting statement.

Additional funds raised via small charity / fund raising events, most of which processed via JustGiving. Goods such as school supplies and gifts to children, as well as football and sport equipment have also been supplied during this period.

Regular maintenance projects have been completed following flood and fire issues.

No Significant changes expected for the organisation or project focus for 2024-2025.

The Trustees present their report together with the financial statement for year ending 31st October 2024.

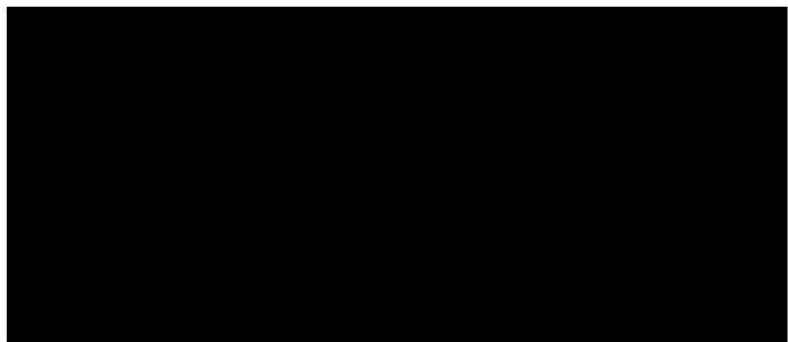

Introduction

Pandi's Legacy is a small non-profit organisation that runs from Montrose, Angus, Scotland incorporated as a SCIO.

The Charity has an income below £250,000 (two hundred and fifty thousand pounds) and as such it is eligible to prepare its accounts on a receipt and payment basis. The governing document body does not require the charity to prepare fully accrued accounts and neither does it require an audit.

The charity mostly comprises of funds being generated through a sponsor program with the nursery and primary schools in Gambia. Goods and additional funds are raised through small fundraising activities which further help support the schools, provides assistance with maintenance and additional local projects such as youth football teams and clinics.
