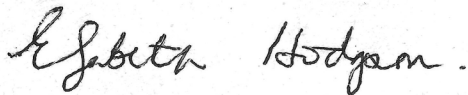
Its Trustees are the volunteer adult leaders trained and appointed as guiders in terms of the guiding manual. Annual update training is available throughout the year.

Independent Examiner's Report
