Basis of independent examiner's statement



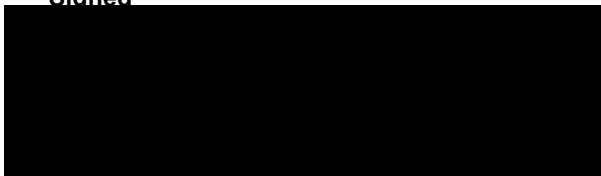

Trustee remuneration and expenses

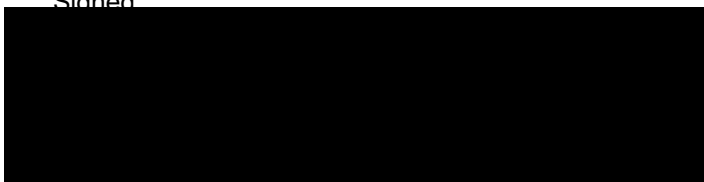
The trustees did not receive any remuneration or reimbursement for expenses during the year.
