This included £3,187 (2024: £3,615) spent on furniture and fittings, and £3,850 (2024: £2,140) given to the World Evangelical Mission, another charity. Other significant expenses were £4,552 (2024: £3,578) for rent, and £7,683 (2024: £10,377) for evangelism materials, training, hospitality, travel, and repairs and maintenance.</p> <p>During the year, our members' spiritual and emotional needs became very significant, so was our effort to ensure these needs were effectively attended to, and where necessary, we referred people to different agencies specialised in the areas of their needs.</p> <p>We look forward to a more glorious and impactful 2026.</p>

Independent Examiner's Report to the Trustees of The Redeemed Christian Church of God, Freedom House, Edinburgh (SC046205)

I report on the accounts of the charity for the year ended 31 March 2025 which are set out on the following pages.

Respective responsibilities of trustees and examiner

The charity's trustees are responsible for the preparation of the accounts in accordance with the terms of the Charities and Trustee Investment (Scotland) Act 2005 and the Charities Accounts (Scotland) Regulations 2006. The charity trustees consider that the audit requirement of Regulation 10(1) (d) of the 2006 Accounts Regulations does not apply. It is my responsibility to examine the accounts as required under section 44(1) (c) of the Act and to state whether particular matters have come to my attention.

Basis of independent examiner's statement

My examination is carried out in accordance with Regulation 11 of the 2006 Accounts Regulations. An examination includes a review of the accounting records kept by the charity and a comparison of the accounts presented with those records. It also includes consideration of any unusual items or disclosures in the accounts, and seeks explanations from the trustees concerning any such matters. The procedures undertaken do not provide all the evidence that would be required in an audit, and consequently I do not express an audit opinion on the view given by the accounts.

Independent examiner's statement

1. which gives me reasonable cause to believe that in any material respect the requirements:
