



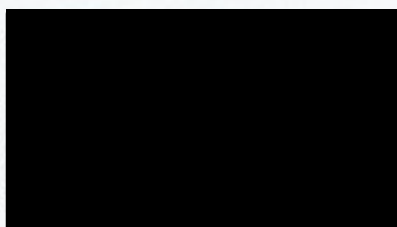

Independent Examiner's Report to the Trustees of World Walking

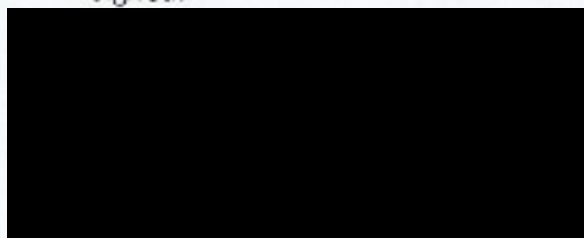

Notes to the Accounts

2024/25 was a successful year for our Charity but unremarkable in terms of the accounts.

No remuneration or expenses were paid to any Trustee during the year.

World Walking Annual Report

Charitable Purpose

The purpose of our charity is the advancement of health.

Main Activity

We aim to achieve our purpose by continuing to make available our free "World Walking" website/app which has been developed simply to motivate people of all ages to walk more and take part in an activity that benefits their health and improves their quality of life.

By creating virtual health walks for an online community of individual walkers and walking groups to complete, our website/app aims to help tackle the negative impact on physical and mental well-being caused by physical inactivity.

2024/25 was another solid year which saw World Walking achieve a significant milestone:

- 100,000 virtual walks completed by our users since our 2013 launch.

During 2024/25 our efforts resulted in:

- The number of World Walking user accounts increasing by 8% to over 242,000.
- The number of virtual walks completed increasing by 17% to over 104,000.
- The total distance walked by World Walking users increasing by 14% to over 71.9 million miles (more than 168.9 billion steps).

Walking 71.9 million miles is the equivalent to walking:

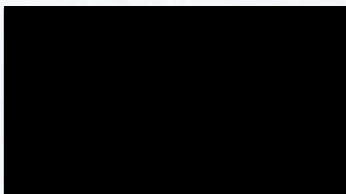
- 2,880 times round the world; or
- To the moon and back more than 150 times.

Constitution

Our charity is regulated by its Constitution which was approved when charitable status was applied for. Charitable status as a SCIO was granted on 8th January 2016.

Trustees may be appointed at any time by way of a resolution passed by majority vote at a board meeting. Trustees retire and are eligible for re-appointment in accordance with our Constitution.

Our Trustees at 31st March 2025 were:




Reserves Policy
