Summary of the main activities in relation to these objects

This year, the charity has not been able to organise fundraising activities due to the rising costs associated with running such events. Expenses including staffing, food, and the hire or maintenance of suitable facilities have increased significantly.

As a small organisation, we must carefully manage our limited resources to ensure funds are directed towards supporting our core charitable work. Unfortunately, the financial risk of hosting events—when the costs of staff, catering, and venues may outweigh the funds raised—meant it was not viable to hold activities this year.

We remain committed to our mission and are continuing to explore more sustainable and cost-effective ways to raise funds and engage with supporters in the future.

APPENDIX 1

Achievements and performance

During the financial period, the charity secured a grant of £5,000 to explore the potential viability of taking over and operating a building that could support the charity's future activities. As part of this work, preliminary assessments were undertaken to determine whether the opportunity would be suitable and sustainable for the organisation. A total of £1,500 of the grant funding was used for this purpose. Unfortunately, the bid to take over the building was ultimately unsuccessful. Other expenditure included fees for internet and web hosting. With funds brought forward from the previous year, this left a sum of £4310.60 in the bank.

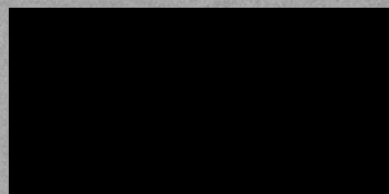
