Summary of the main activities in relation to these objects

To encourage the enjoyment of study by those who are retired or ex-services in Caithness and North Sutherland; support suitable study at NHC/UHI or the Open University; offer a measure of financial support up to the value of £1,000 per annum to one or more appropriate recipients where financial considerations create a restraint to the pursuit of this study; decide on the allocation of this sum, after due consideration, by mid-August each year. Due to a lack of interest, our activities have extended to provide funding to groups providing access to music and singing to young and old people.

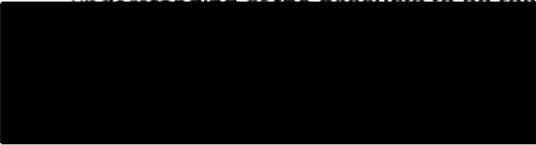
