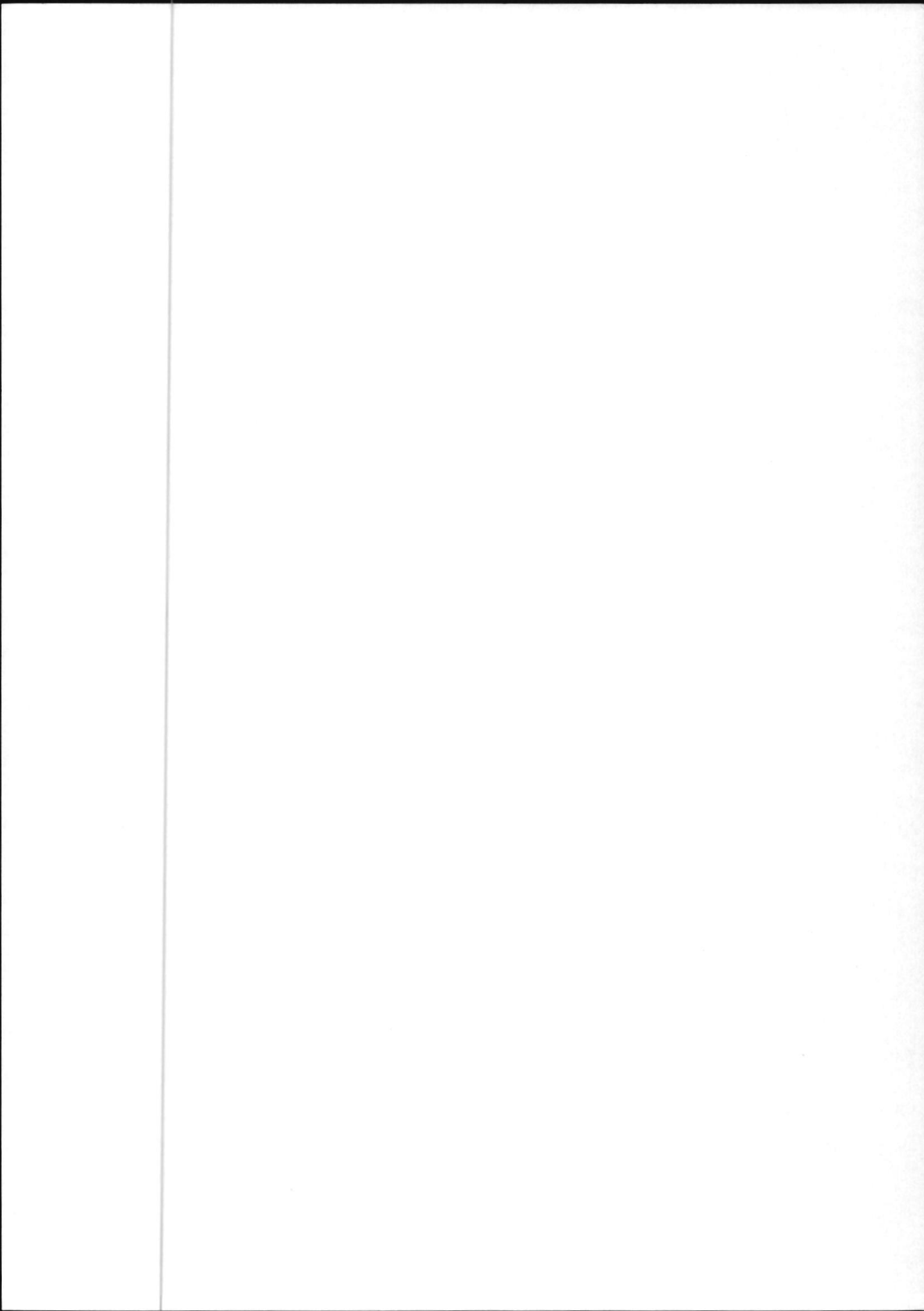

Independent examiner's statement


