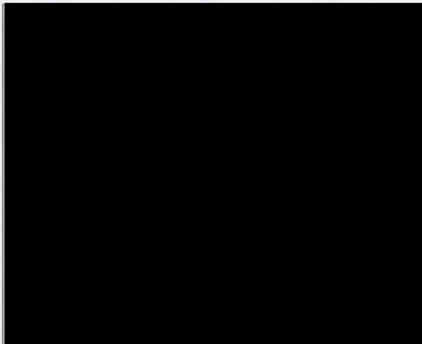

STRUCTURE, GOVERNANCE AND MANAGEMENT

Governing document

The Charity is controlled by its governing document and deed of trust.

The project is recognised as charity in Scotland, is registered as a SCIO (Scottish Charitable Incorporated Organisation) and was set up by a model constitution on 15* November 2016.

Recruitment and appointment of new trustees

The Management of the charity is the responsibility of the trustees who are elected under the terms of the constitution.

Risk Management

The trustees have a duty to identify and review the risks to which the charity is exposed and to ensure appropriate controls are in place to provide reasonable assurance against fraud and error.

Constitution

The Charity is a Scottish Charitable Incorporated Organisation, registered on 16 November 2016. The assets of the previous unincorporated club were transferred to the SCIO on 16 November 2016. It has a single tier structure.

Trustees are elected at the Annual General Meeting which is held in March annually and there must be a minimum of three.

Objectives and Activities

The club meets for pursuits of photographic enjoyment and learning and is open to all. Meetings are held fortnightly on a Wednesday nights from early September to early April. During this year we had more instructions in the use of Photoshop and light room planned for the benefits for all members but again Covid has changed that.

The club normally takes part in competitions with four other clubs from in towns around us and also have entries in the Agricultural competition held in neighbouring town as well as hosting the Border Photographic Exhibition. This is open to all which attracts entries from far a field and is judged by a different independent judge every year. This is held in the local church hall which has kitchen and disabled access facilities. Usually attracting over 200 entries of mounted prints and over 100 projected images. Over 80 people from other clubs and members of the public normally ascend on the opening night when Trophies and Certificates are awarded to the winners. Then we provide Food and coffee tea provided by the members SCC.

The club also provide Speakers and judges from other towns when requested. The club now went to fortnightly due to Covid

Financial Review

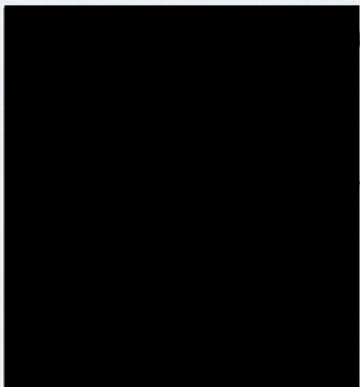
With the reduction in membership and the increase in insurance and energy costs we are no longer able to meet our output needs from our Members Annual Subscriptions, this has been the trend since Covid.
