**What the charity does:** Perth First Responders Charity is set up to support community first responders in Perth by providing funding for essential training and equipment. Our aim is to ensure responders are confident, skilled, and prepared to deliver life-saving care in emergency situations. We do this by funding monthly training sessions using appropriate training equipment, helping responders maintain and develop their emergency response skills. We also provide free CPR and AED awareness demonstrations to the public, helping to improve community knowledge and confidence in responding to cardiac emergencies. By supporting first responders and educating the public, we help strengthen community resilience and improve the chances of survival in life-threatening situations.

**Objectives:** 4 The organisation's purposes are: 4.1 Provision of prompt and appropriate medical care for persons in distress, or suffering life threatening conditions 4.2 Providing CPR and AED assistance when required 4.3 Training members of the public in CPR, (in line with the Scottish Government out of hospital Cardiac Arrest Strategy), thus helping to increase the chances of someone surviving an out of hospital cardiac arrest 4.4 The promotion of Public Access Defibrillators in local communities

## **Perth First Responders Charity Chairman's Report**

I am pleased to present this report on behalf of the operations team, highlighting the activities and developments within Perth First Responders over the past year.

Over the reporting period, our dedicated volunteers have collectively contributed an outstanding **1,188.8 operational hours** and responded to **120 emergency calls**. This reflects the continued commitment, professionalism, and willingness of our responders to support the community and assist the ambulance service when needed.

We have also been very proactive with our fundraising efforts. We continue to receive support through the Co-op Community Fund, which has enabled us to deliver Community First Responder (CFR) and Automated External Defibrillator (AED) awareness and demonstration sessions within our local community. These sessions are vital in helping to improve public confidence and preparedness in responding to medical emergencies.

We are proud that one of our first responders has now qualified as a paramedic, reflecting the high standard of training and commitment within the group. In addition, two new Community First Responders have joined the Perth group, strengthening our team and helping to ensure the continued delivery of our service.

It is with great sadness that we report the loss of **Catherine Procter** in November 2024. Catherine was one of our original founding responders and served as charity secretary. Her dedication, professionalism, and passion played a vital role in establishing and shaping the organisation. She will be deeply missed by all who knew and worked with her.
