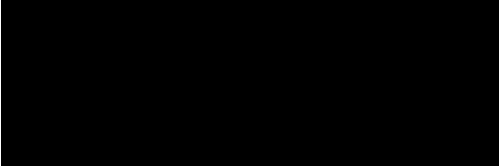
ACHIEVEMENTS AND PERFORMANCE
