Trustees are elected by the members of the organisation at an AGM and appointed for an initial 3 year term which may be extended by one further 3 year term if so elected after which a Trustee will not be eligible for appointment until the following AGM. The Trustees may co-opt and appoint additional Trustees as considered necessary. A Priest/Lay Leader appointed by the member Trustees also becomes a Trustee of the charity.

APPENDIX 1

Achievements and performance

Summary of the main achievements of the charity during the financial period

The charity has continued to work with other charities to support their work with families, those needing help post addiction, Street Pastor training and mentoring people of all ages in employment with some moving into career destinations.

Following the closure of the coffee shop run by the charity subsidiary company (CAF4E CIC), alternative options for similar operations were explored but have not yet come to fruition. Although the decision was taken to dissolve the activities of the subsidiary company and remit the remaining funds to the charity, the dissolution has not yet been completed but the charity has already received the substantial part of the funds previously generated by the company.

The trustees are continuing to explore further opportunities to expand its activities within the local community around the Aberdeen area.

APPENDIX 1

Financial review

Brief statement of the charity's policy on reserves

It is the policy of the Missional Community to fund activity from ongoing revenue rather than to accumulate reserves. The current reserves of £44,039 are a result of a significant donations from the subsidiary company following closure of the coffee shop activity. The trustees will consider the most suitable use of these funds when the charity is wound up in the near future.

There were no deficits on funds at the end of the period.

There were no donated services during this period.

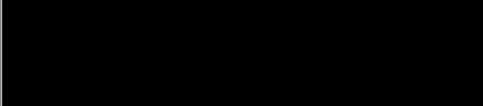
Financial Viability.

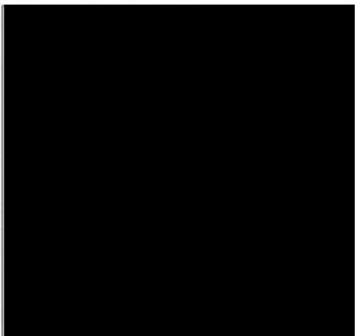
