The organisation will promote and encourage participation in local beach clean groups and display information about local marine ecology and protection in the building and hold periodic age specific educational seminars in cooperation with the Community of Arran Seabed Trust.

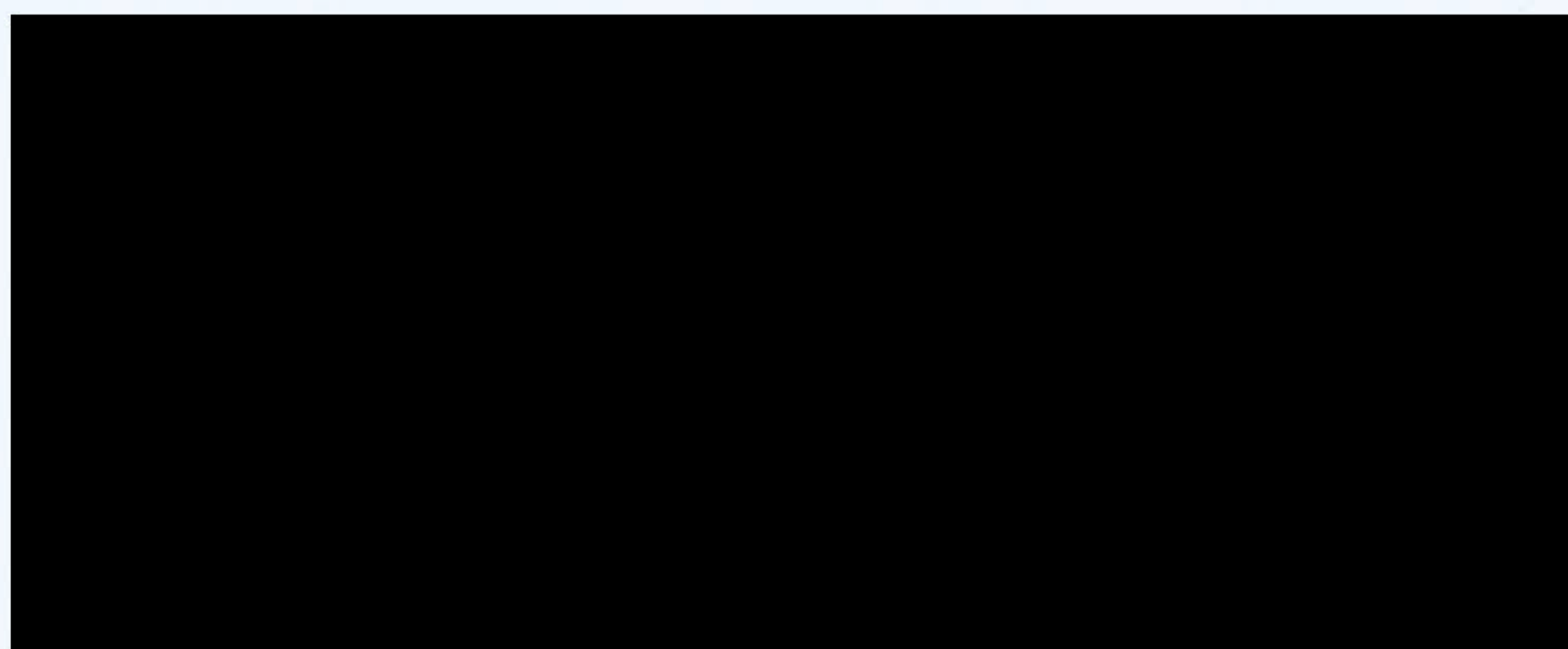


Basis of Independent Examiners Report
