North Lanarkshire Chiefs Basketball Club is an incorporated Scottish Charitable Organisation (SC047704) governed by its constitution 04/09/2017.

Trustee recruitment and appointment

The management committee, which normally meets quarterly, consists of both the charity trustees and non-voting members. Membership of the management committee is open to all parents/guardians of club members as well as club coaches and senior players.

Trustees are elected at the annual general meeting, which is held at the end of the season, typically in June. There must be a minimum of three and a maximum of eight trustees.

Achievements and performance

Summary of the main achievements of the charity during the financial period

Demand for the club continues to be high.

For the 23/24 season we had 4 National League (the top league in the country) teams competing.

Our Senior Men team competed in division 2 finishing in 6th position out of 10 with 9 wins and 9 losses.

The Under 18 men team competed in division 2 finishing 2nd of 7 with 12 wins and 3 losses.

Our Under 16 men competed in division 1 finishing 8th position out of 8 with 2 wins and 18 losses.

The Under 14 men competed in division 2 finishing 6th of 9 with 3 wins and 5 defeats.

One of our Under 18 players were chosen for the Scotland team.

Our Senior Men local league team won the Robert Taft Cup.

During this season we also ran an Under 18s development team for the first time, taking part in a competitive league.

Financial review

The trustee's policy is to retain 3 months of normal running costs to meet commitments and to cover any unexpected expenditure. At the end of the year, the reserves were £ 15504, which exceeds our target range.
