What the charity does: We aim to reduce poverty, provide nutritional benefits by providing facilities for local residents to grow their own food. More than 50 individual and group members are leased raised planter beds to grow their produce of. choice. Group education is provided by a local college. The secure environment includes a small orchard , shrubbery and rest facilities. A car park is provided for local residents to reduce on street parking.
