Parent helpers, peers and lifeguards supported qualified coaches. • Club nights (Monday and Thursdays) Bridge of Earn during winter mobile floodlighting enables stamina and slalom technique training to continue. • Wednesday evenings (light permitting) continued the clubs park and play and river trips from Stanley Beach. A mixture of coached white water technique and peer organised river trips for junior and adult non competitive paddlers. • Saturday mornings , primarily for beginners and non- competitive adults enjoyed river trips from Bridge of Earn. • Variable weekend performance coaching at Grandtully in the first half of the year. • Continued collaboration for competitive paddlers with CRCats and Pinkston Panthers to widen training opportunities • Several paddlers and families joined the annual French coaching trip to St Pierre and l'argentina for warm weather training

Competitions:

- Paddlers competed across all age groups and divisions with several paddlers gaining promotion in the ranking divisions.
- Senior Paddlers competed and trained in international venues across Europe
- The club was represented in all competitive slalom divisions junior and senior throughout the race season

- The club encountered challenges with high water. Parent helpers assisted in reestablishing gates.
- Paddlers regularly support river clean up operations, removing debris from the water to reduce pollution
- Relaxed river trips include nature spotting of local wildlife including, fish, otters, beaver and Osprey's


