The Charity was able to work with Mental Health organisations that were able to provide us with Mental Health Practitioners who were able to assist some of our service users with Mental Health Concerns, Issues and assistance. This program will be continuing in 2026, as we have identified that Mental Health challenges are some of the basic causes of heavy substance abuse.

The Charity was able to be awarded grants by Glasgow Credit Union and expects to receive more grants in 2026. The principal and other Trustees have attended seminars and courses that advice and help in drafting grant award winning proposals and these have been very helpful in fulfilling our future purposes. During our sporting activities we were able to signpost some our service users to organisations that provide employability skills. This has been beneficial to our service users as some have managed to acquire work related training and jobs.
