- Other activities on hold due to changes from outcome of Covid-19 pandemic.

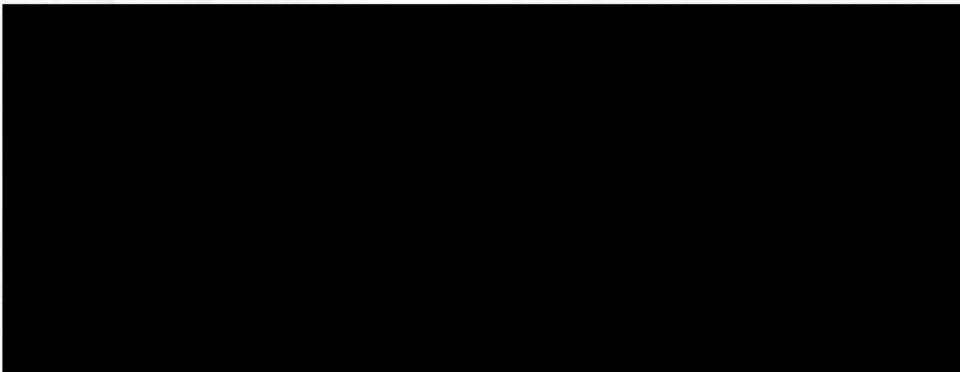
Finance
