It was set up to: - Spearhead the regeneration of New Cumnock. - Work in partnership with other private, voluntary and public sector organisations to realise the hopes and priorities of the local community. - Reduce dependency on grant support by generating income through enterprise and the ownership of assets. A big focus throughout the year has been on progressing the 2 capital refurbishment projects - at the former Castle Hotel and the Trotters building.
