The Pine Project aims to use technology to help develop, support and grow existing user communities.

Our first project is the development of an app to support people in Dundee in recovery from addiction to drugs or alcohol. Modelled on the successful ARC-Edinburgh app, this app aims to work with existing groups and support to make the times, location and services of their community facilities easier to access to others through the creation of an app.

An app like this will help focus service users to a single point of contact, making information easier to access as well as providing an opportunity to highlight other services or information which may be relevant but lesser known
