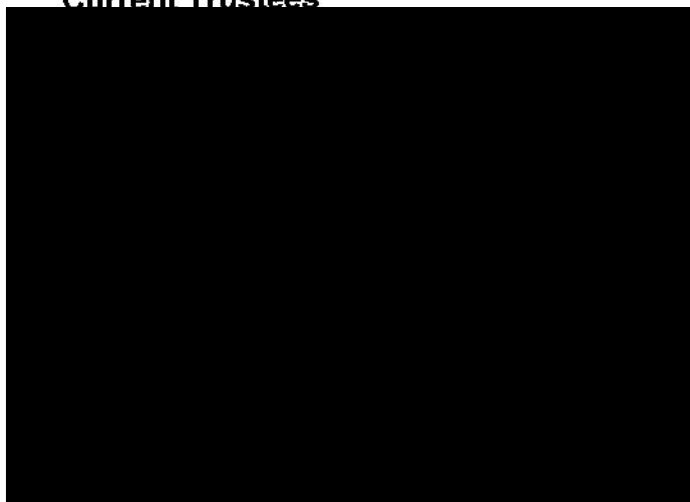

## **Structure, Governance and Management**

### **Constitution**

The Charity is a Scottish Charitable Incorporated Organisation (SCIO). It was registered in its current legal form on 7<sup>th</sup> January 2019

### **Appointment of Trustees**

The Board of Trustees are the Charity Trustees

A person will not be eligible for election or appointment to the board if he/she is: -

- 1 disqualified from being a Charity Trustee under the Charities and Trustee Investment (Scotland) Act 2005; or
- 2 an employee of the organisation.

New Trustees are elected at the Annual General Meeting which normally is held in November. There must be a minimum of 5 and maximum of 12 Trustees. At each Annual General Meeting one third of our existing Trustees will stand down.

## **Objects and Activities**

### **Charitable Purposes**

- The relief of those in need by reason of age, ill-health, disability, financial hardship or other disadvantage through the provision small grants, donations or support to community groups, charities and individuals.

### **Activities**

- Organise and host events and leisure activities for sections or the whole community to participate in.
- Undertake a range of fundraising activities.
- Provision of small grants.
- Involve members of the local community in finding solutions to previously identified needs, e.g. social isolation.

Report to the Trustees of 'Besty's', Registered Charity number SC048938 on the accounts for the period ended 31<sup>st</sup> March 2022

### **Respective Responsibilities of the Trustees and Examiner**

The charity's trustees are responsible for the preparation of the accounts in accordance with the terms of the Charities and Trustee Investment (Scotland) 2005 Act and the Charities Accounts (Scotland) Regulations 2006. The charity trustees consider that the audit requirement of Regulation 10(1) (d) of the Accounts Regulations does not apply. ### **Basis of Independent Examiner's Statement**

The procedures undertaken do not provide all the evidence that would be required in an audit, and, consequently, I do not express an audit opinion on the accounts.
