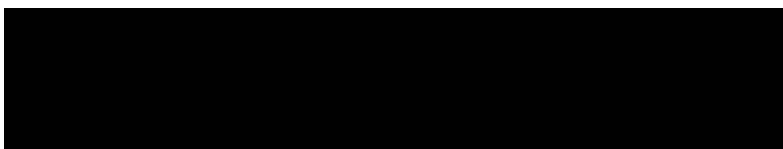
The Trustees present their report and independently examined accounts for the year ended 30 June 2024.

Constitution

Working in conjunction with North Ayrshire foodbank, we have been able to cook and provide meals for those in most need.

The community hub/café gives us a base to continue providing food relief where required. We also hold activities and classes to encourage our community to come along and form friendships and in turn provide support for each other.

Financial Review

Reserves Policy

The Charity does not exercise a formal reserves policy. Restricted and unrestricted funds are disclosed at page 3 of the accounts. The Trustees consider all funds to be unrestricted.
