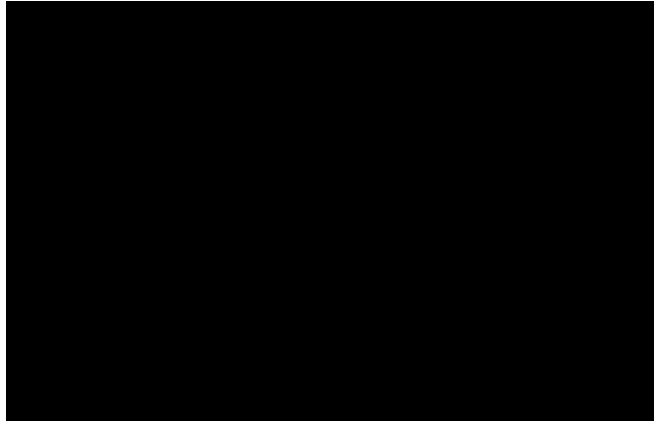

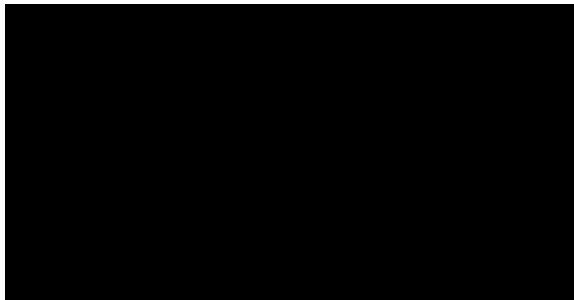

Kemnay School Parent Group is a Scottish Charitable Incorporated Organisation governed by its constitution. It was formed on the 20 September 2019.

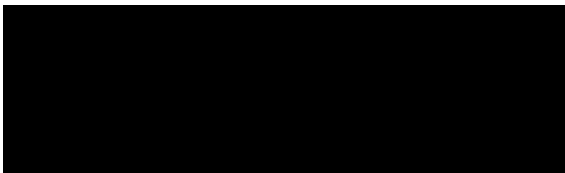
Its Trustees are the volunteers who have an interest in supporting the work of Kemnay Primary School. Trustee training is provided throughout the year as and when is necessary.
