The advancement of citizenship or community development by providing resources and support to communities and working with communities to assist them in the conservation, management and promotion of their local sites of geological interest. 4.4. The advancement of the arts heritage culture and science by promotion of the science of geology, by encouraging recognition of the role of geology in creating landscape and sense of place, and by supporting projects that engage the arts to interpret Scotland's landscape and geological heritage in innovative ways.
