Activities

Activities: 'It carries out activities or services itself'

Purposes: 'the advancement of education', 'the advancement of health', 'the advancement of citizenship or community development', 'the advancement of human rights, conflict resolution or reconciliation'

What the charity does: The Peace Advocate Programme seeks to recognise and acknowledge the innate expertise of young people, enable them to resolve conflict and embrace success. This empowers them to become leaders of the 21st century in their schools and communities. The charity encourages a conflict resolution philosophy in the participants enabling young people and adults to become Peace Advocates. Through interactive learning opportunities schools and community groups work towards achieving the International Blue Peace Schools accredited Flag Award. In order to achieve the Blue Flag status the Peace Advocates engage in activities to learn the 3 skills of Peace and Conflict resolution, followed by planning and delivering projects that benefit their communities. Finally, facilitate the learning programme for a new cohort of Peace Advocates. This advances their citizenship by liaising and building local and global networks to promote a culture of peace.

Beneficiaries: 'No specific group, or for the benefit of the community'

Objectives: 4 The Objects for which the company is established are: 1. The advancement of conflict resolution by encouraging a conflict resolution philosophy in young people in countries across the world and enabling young people and adults to become 'Peace Advocates'. 2. The advancement of education by training and accrediting facilitators to create and organize 'Peace and Conflict Resolution' groups in schools and communities and promoting equal status for life skills (such as conflict resolution skills) in the school curriculum. 3. The advancement of citizenship by liaising and building local and global networks to promote a culture of peace and enabling 'Peace and Conflict Resolution' groups to identify problems in their

community that can be tackled using conflict resolution skills. 4. The advancement of health by promoting the knowledge and understanding of the impact of mental health on behaviour and offering skills to allow young people to take control of their mental health problems and empower them to improve their own health and that of others.
