The trustees have pleasure in presenting their report together with the financial statements for the year ended 31 December 2023.

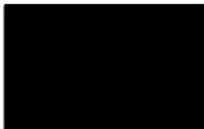

Structure, Governance and Management Constitution

The Charity is a Scottish Charitable Incorporated Organisation (a SCIO). It was registered in its current legal form under the name Scottish Motoring Heritage Trust on 20 January 2020. Its name was changed to Scottish Motor Museum Trust SCIO on 4 August 2024.

It has a single tier structure and as such the trustees are the members of the charity.

The current trustees are the original trustees of the Charity appointed on its incorporation.

Trustees are appointed by the trustees by majority vote.

There must be a minimum of three and a maximum of seven trustees

Objectives and Activities Charitable purposes

The purposes of the Charity are the advancement of the education of the public in relation to the history and culture of motor vehicle and transport generally and to Scottish motor vehicles and transport in particular, by associating voluntary organisations, local authorities and other bodies of whatever status, together with the public in the Scotland in a common effort to preserve the vehicles, memorabilia and literature relating to such history.

Achievements and performance

The Charity has not yet commenced activities. It intends in due course to carry on various activities in succession to the Scottish Motor Museum trust and continues to work towards that.

The Charity has not yet had any financial transactions (2022 Nil).

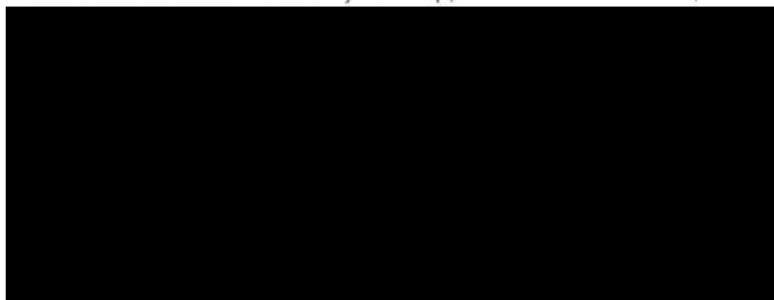
Reserves policy

The trustees declare that they have approved the trustees' report above

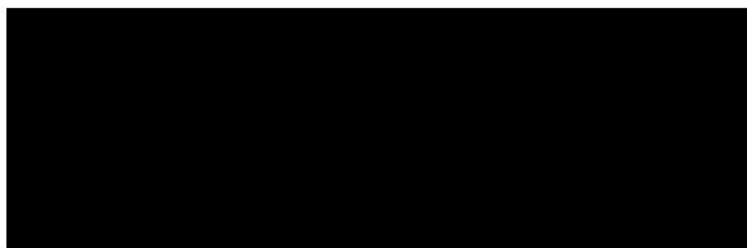
