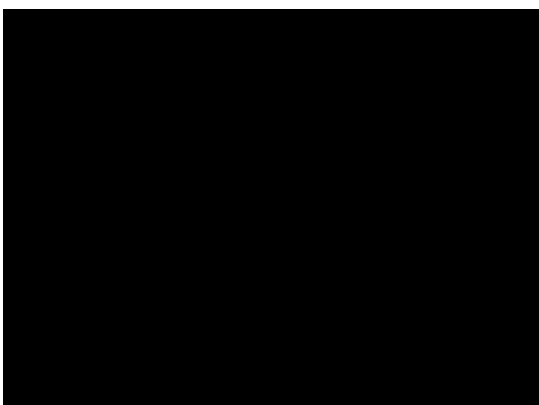

Trustee recruitment and appointment

We have had no new trustee recruitment within 2024 although we are actively seeking for trustees that want to be involved in the running of the charity, we have reached out to our membership to see if anyone is willing to become more involved.

Achievements and performance

- During 2024 we succeeded in our main charitable purpose of furthering participation in sport with our membership increasing to around 430 people. We have also managed to support those that are unable to pay due to individual circumstances to ensure that football is available to all.
- We have continued our support of the Back Onside charity by including their branding on all of our home and away shirts at no cost throughout the year.
- We have held our annual Kinross-shire Friendship Cup which sees teams of unaccompanied Child refugees compete against a selection of our own teams in a festival which we hold.
- We have added a new team in 2024 which is our 2019's team to ensure we still have an unbroken pathway from the age of 5 through to our walking football which has no upper age limit.
- We have focused on expanding our ladies football offering which now boasts a very healthy weekly turnout of ladies playing in a fun environment.

Our charity operates a reserves policy, and our treasurer compiles regular cash flow forecasts which are briefed to the trustees. The treasurer is responsible for ensuring that funds are in place to cover all anticipated and unanticipated costs.

Our club rules document states that "The Trustees will ensure that the anticipated annual revenue generated from subscriptions, sponsorship, fundraising and any other means will always exceed the anticipated normal annual expenditure of the club. This will ensure the financial viability of the club".

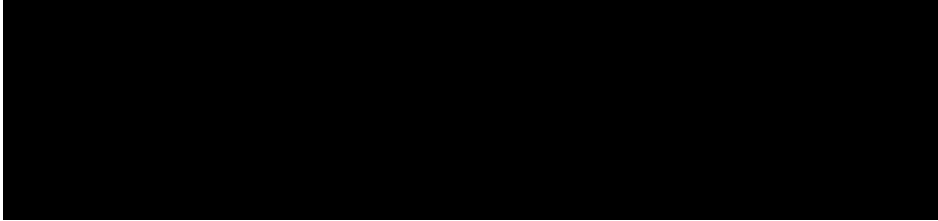
