What the charity does: The Monimail Tower Project (MTP) is centred around the historic Monimail Tower, its surrounding walls, gardens, orchard, and woodland. We are a charitable organisation committed to preserving and promoting the heritage of this special place. The tower, orchard, and woodland are open to the public year-round, while the garden has more limited access — primarily used by house residents, MTP directors, and allotmenters, though we do occasionally host public events in the garden as well. MTP is a lively, inclusive, and welcoming hub for people — a place of creativity, relaxation, reflection, craft, and celebration. We actively support biodiversity, organic growing, and sustainable living practices, and we are closely connected to local community projects and events. (j) To secure the establishment and management of a residential centre for activities promoted by the project in furtherance of the above objects or any of them.
