Hidden Door operates on a unique volunteer-led model, with a core team of dedicated individuals overseeing the planning and execution of its events. This enables us to be ambitious, agile and source skills and expertise beyond what otherwise might be available to us. Through our signature event, our annual Hidden Door Festival, we have transformed 11 stunning spaces into exciting and immersive sites in Edinburgh since 2014, enabling visitors to discover new creative talent across a range of art forms, while providing paid work for over 3,000 artists and performers.
