Trustee recruitment and appointment

1. At each AGM, the members may elect any member to be a charity trustee (unless he/she is debarred from membership under clause 61 and 62).  
 2. The board may at any time appoint any member (unless he/she is debarred from membership under clause 61 and 62) to be a charity trustee.  
 3. Charity Trustees are elected for a period of two [2] years, but are then eligible for re-election under clause 67.  
 . A charity trustee retiring at an AGM will be deemed to have been re-elected unless: -  
 . he/she advises the board prior to the conclusion of the AGM that he/she does not wish to be re-appointed as a charity trustee; or  
 a. an election process was held at the AGM and he/she was not among those elected/re-elected through that process; or  
 b. a resolution for the re-election of that charity trustee was put to the AGM and was not carried.

### Achievements and performance

#### Summary of the main achievements of the charity during the financial period

Continued on successes of previous year, operating 5 coaching sessions per week for players of various ages and playing abilities.

Installed semi-permanent courts and storage facilities on Troon Beach to improve ease of access to equipment for our members.

Worked with local council and other stakeholders to help develop the first inland beach volleyball courts in Ayrshire.

Hosted UK Beach Tour Events.

Hosted Scottish Volleyball Junior National Championships.

Built on member numbers from previous year.

Gained approximately £2,800 in grants to support in activities. These funds were primarily used to provide funded junior memberships to children from deprived backgrounds.

Utilised membership management system (Class4Kids) for all coaching sessions.

### Financial review

The charity does not currently need a reserve policy but will revisit this in the future if necessary

#### Details of any deficit

The deficit has arisen, largely due to a large overseas payment for equipment, which included import taxes, and repaying loans from volunteers for equipment in 2020 and 2021. Subsidised memberships and other support was given to members who were selected to represent Scotland at the Youth Commonwealth Games.

Number of entries for competitions were reduced compared to previous years, resulting in reduced income.
