What the charity does: Helensburgh Community Hall Ltd, (known as Helensburgh Community Hub) purchased the hall at 113 East Princes Street in Helensburgh in 2020, to run it as a community facility. The Hub has a hall which is available to hire by any community groups. We have a suite of offices which are leased by other third sector organisations and we operate a second hand book shop selling donated books As well as managing the facilities we run our own programmes which are currently a) promoting reading for pleasure which includes a local program of Dolly Parton's Imagination Library and an annual book festival run jointly with other local charities b) encouraging and valuing volunteering including an annual volunteer thanking event. ~And c) we have recently begun to engage with community resilience initiatives We have a very hands on group of Trustees, a paid development manager and an army of volunteers.
