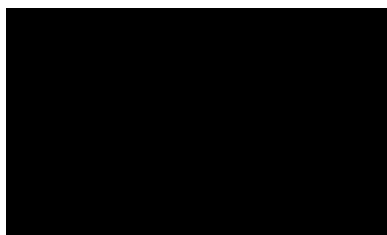

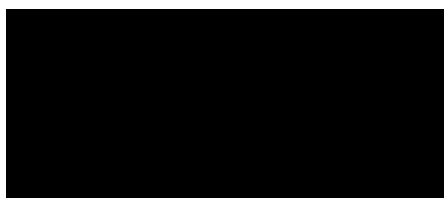
Annual Report
