To achieve this, we empower our global member organisations, collaborate with other Humanist organisations, and engage with international bodies to advocate for humanist principles and policies. We raise funds through various methods, including membership fees from member organisations, general donations, regular (monthly or annual) contributions, donations to fundraising appeals, legacy gifts, and grants from trusts and foundations.
