recreational facilities, or the organisation of recreational activities, with the object of improving the conditions of life for the persons for whom the facilities or activities are primarily intended. 5.3.8 the relief of those in need by reason of age, ill-health, disability, financial hardship or other disadvantage. 5.3.9 the relief of unemployment. and 5.3.10 any other purpose that may reasonably be regarded as analogous to any of the preceding purposes. 5.4 For the purposes of the Taxes Acts the provisions set out in clause 5.1 to 5.3 shall be read together to ensure the Charitable Purposes are compliant with the Taxes Acts.
