What the charity does: BUTA Azerbaijan-Scotland Association exists to connect and strengthen the Azerbaijani community in Scotland. The charity is aiming at building bridges of understanding with the wider Scottish public. We do this by promoting Azerbaijani language, culture and heritage through community events, educational activities, cultural programs. We run regular women's gatherings to reduce isolation and build connection, we are developing weekend sessions for children and adults focused on language learning, cultural identity, community belonging. We also support community members with information and signposting and advocate for civic participation and voluntary engagement. Through all of this, we work to ensure that Azerbaijani heritage has a valued place within Scotland's multicultural society.
