For the period ended 31 July 2024

The Trustees have pleasure in presenting their report and the financial statements for the charity for the period ended 31 July 2024. The Trustees have adopted the provisions of Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and the Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2019).

Funds are used for weekly activities and badgework as well as buying badges for rewards. Annually each member has to pay the Scout Association subscription which is paid into the accounts by parents and paid out by the group. As the group is growing a lot of funds are being used to improve camping equipment and resources such as sports equipment. The scout group will also assist where required any young person who would otherwise miss out on activities due to cost.

A large number of expensed items go through the Group Scout Leader. [REDACTED] pays for a lot of items on a personal credit card and claims this back as we are finding less places will issue an invoice for us to pay directly from our accounts. The group have a plan in place to try and arrange prepaid credit cards to be used in such an event rather than any leader being out of pocket.

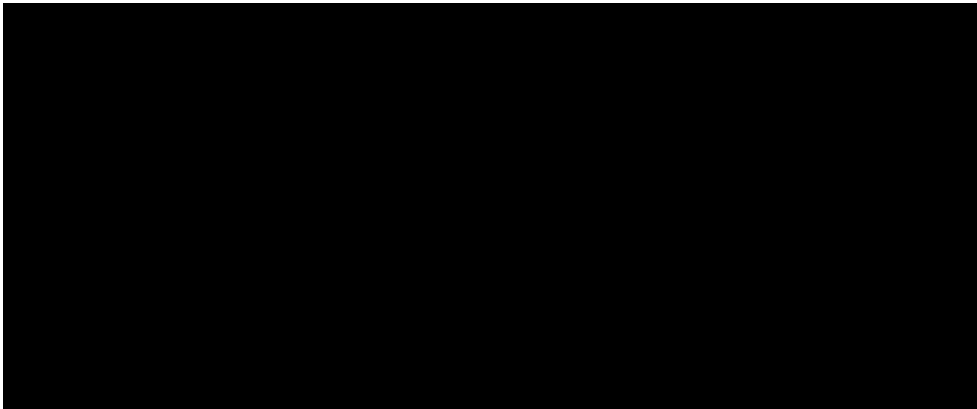

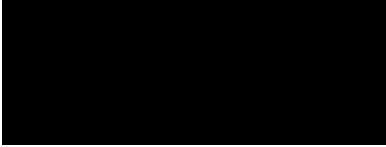

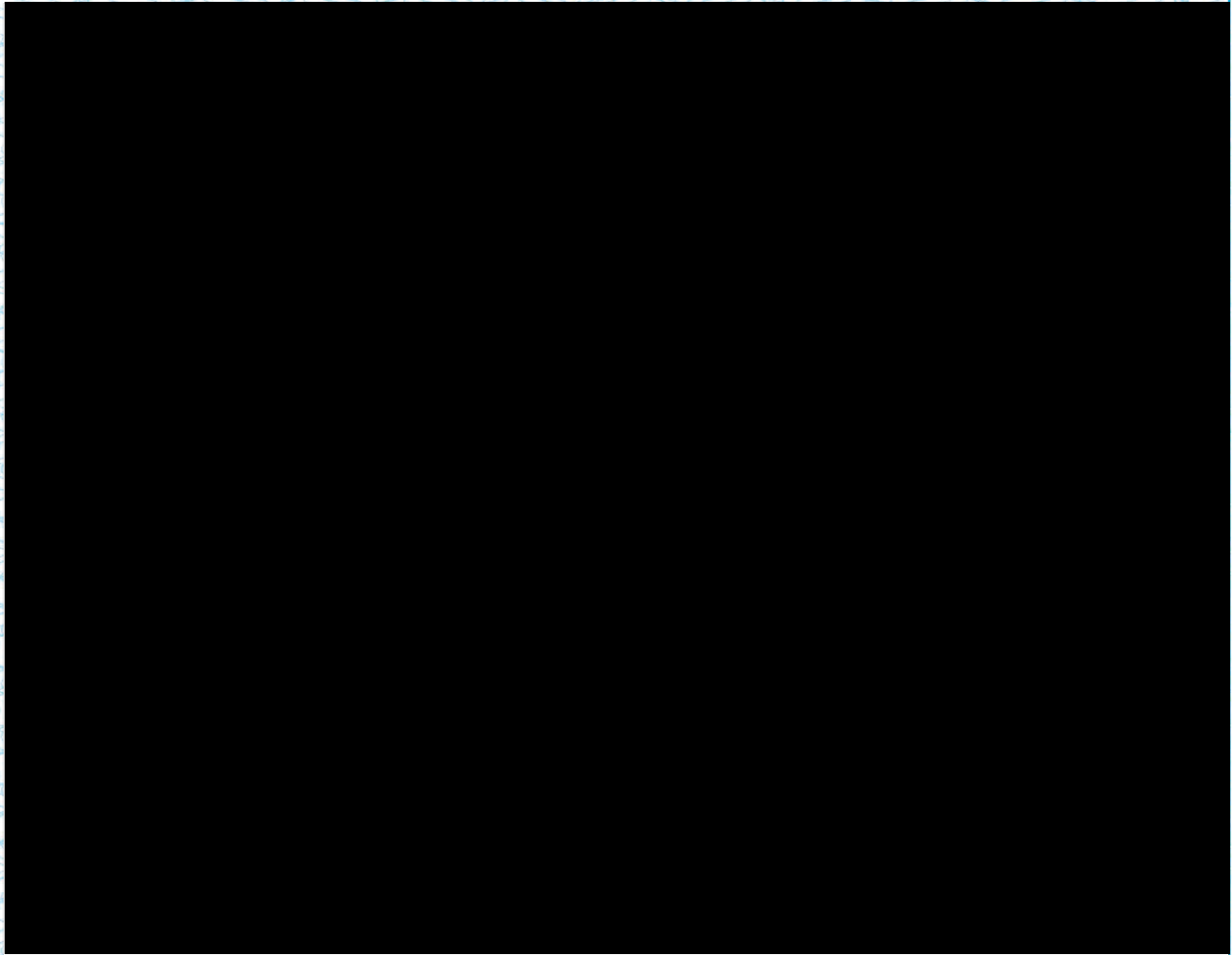
