Care for the environment, growing food locally and healthy eating and cooking opportunities. 4.3 Develop health and welfare improvements, setting targets for reducing obesity, smoking and alcohol/substance abuse, increase participation in sporting activities, improving childcare and services to at risk families and developing IT awareness and skills across all age ranges. 4.4 Encourage a spirit of enterprise amongst residents and promote greater self-reliance through community training opportunities, achieved through development of social enterprise and local employment. Actively encourage tolerance and understanding to promote community harmony, equality and

diversity.
