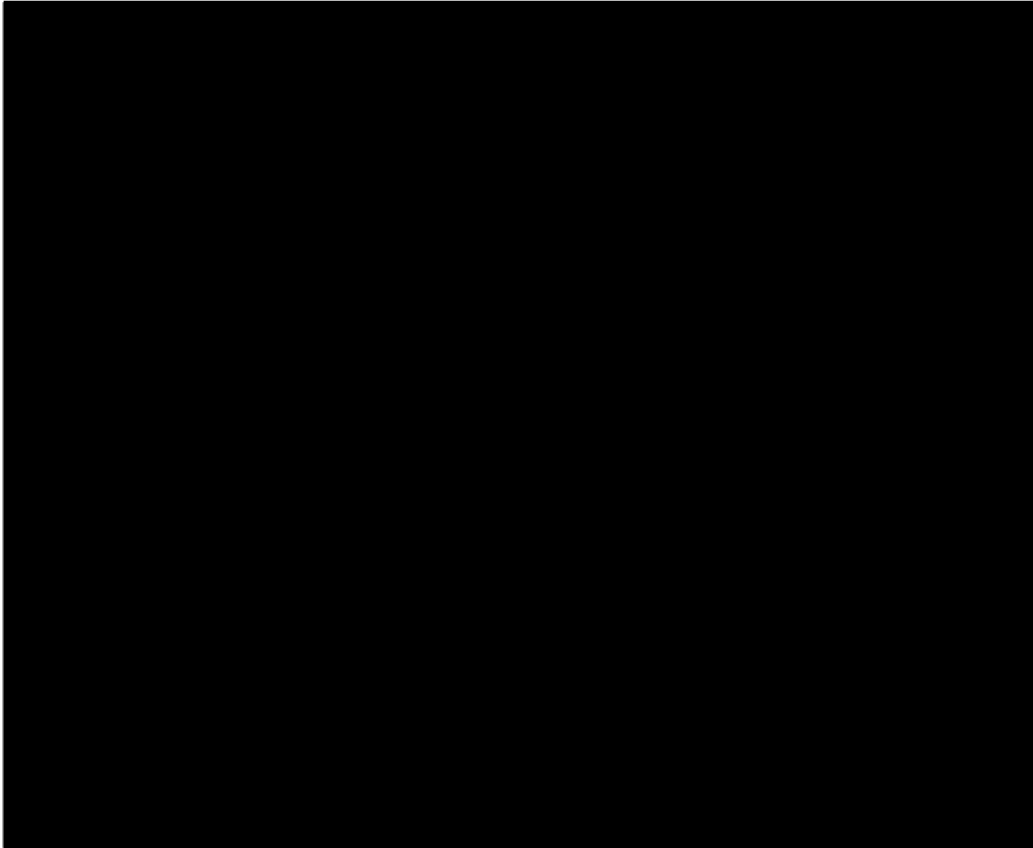

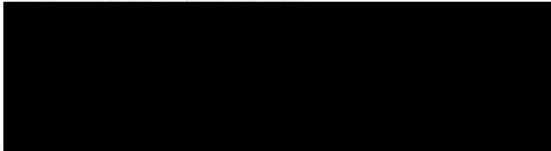

Activities

Statement of Responsibilities of Members

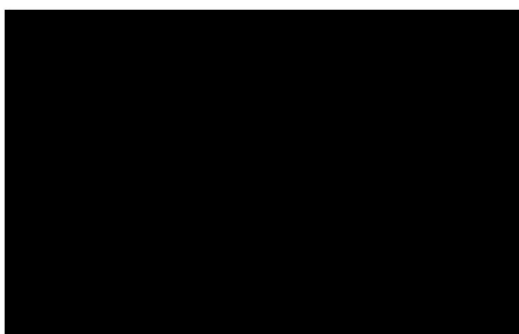
