Activities: 'It carries out activities or services itself'

Purposes: 'the advancement of citizenship or community development', 'the advancement of the arts, heritage, culture or science', 'the advancement of public participation in sport', 'the provision of recreational facilities, or the organisation of recreational activities, with the object of improving the conditions of life for the persons for whom the facilities or activities are primarily intended', 'the advancement of environmental protection or improvement'

What the charity does: The community Trust, a charity, has been established to represent, support and promote the village of Balmacara and its residents. The Trust does this through events and activities. It has purchased Balmacara Woodland Park and is currently restoring the Old Mill Hall as a community gathering space. It does this through grant applications and fundraising activity.

Beneficiaries: 'No specific group, or for the benefit of the community'

Objectives: The company has been formed to benefit principally the community of Balmacara which comprises the Lochalsh Community Council area ('the Community') with the following objects: a) The advancement of citizenship or community development to promote for the public benefit rural regeneration, following principles of sustainable development, where 'sustainable development' means development which meets the needs of the present without compromising the ability of future generations to meet their own needs, in areas of social and economic deprivation within the Community. b) The advancement of local heritage and arts through the creation of training, education, and employment opportunities. the preservation of buildings or sites of architectural, historic, or other importance to the Community. c) The advancement of public participation in sport by offering sporting activity for the public at large and/or those who, by reasons of

their age, ill health, disability, poverty, or social and economic circumstances, have need of such activity. d) The provision of local recreational facilities by offering services and rental of spaces on favourable terms to the community for events that improve the social and economic wellbeing of the Community. e) To advance environmental protection or improvement including preservation, sustainable development and conservation of the natural environment, the maintenance, improvement, or provision of environmental amenities for the Community
