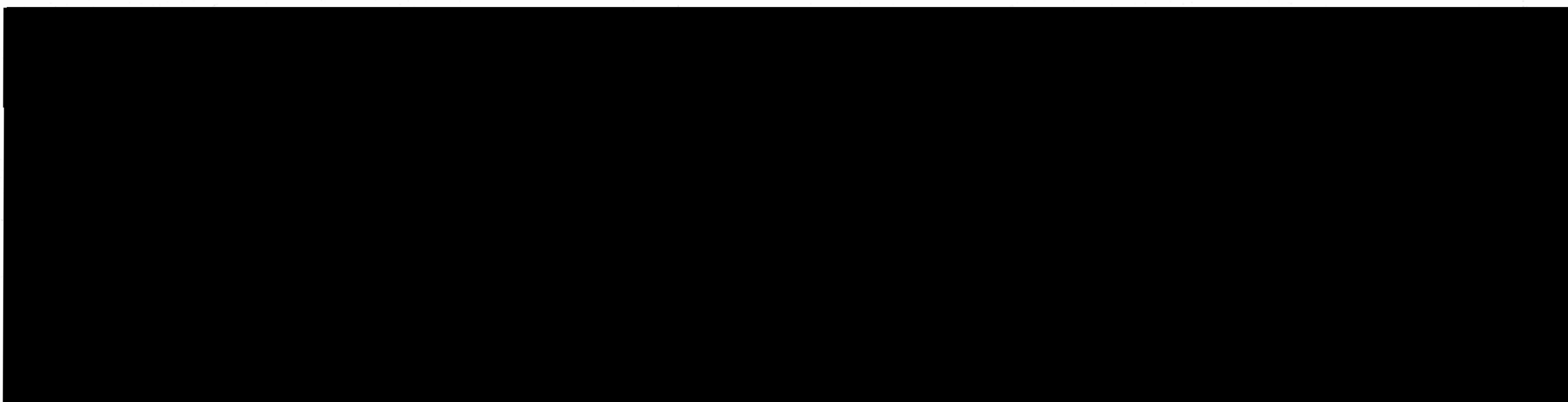

An end-of-year trustees meeting for this year was held at the Black Door Shop, Orchardhill Parish Church.


