During the year 2025/26 the charity increase income by nearly 50% and recorded a small operating deficit of £1,653. The work of the charity continued to expand, with nearly 800 Yoga4Health teachers trained and Yoga4NHS Staff Wellbeing delivered to a total of over 1,000.
