##### **Significant activities**

Another positive year of subscriptions and fundraising which has been invested into refurbishment of our new ground. This should facilitate future growth in the club and further improvement of the site incrementally going forward.

#### **FINANCIAL REVIEW**

##### **Financial position**

At the end of the year to 30 June 2025, closing bank balances amounted to £17,082 and there was a surplus of funds of £119,425. The charity capitalised the costs of the ground refurbishment and are writing the value of this off over the next 10 years.

#### **FUTURE PLANS**

We have significant fundraising efforts planned for the next twelve months which should facilitate future growth in the project fund with the aim of building up a cash reserve for any unforeseen costs arising from managing our own premises.

##### **Basis of preparing the financial statements**

The financial statements of the charitable company, which is a public benefit entity under FRS 102, have been prepared in accordance with the Charities SORP (FRS 102) 'Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2019)', Financial Reporting Standard 102 'The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland' and the Companies Act 2006. 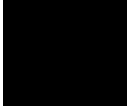
