We have boys teams from 7 through to 20years old Girls teams from 7 through to 13 years old and an over 35 team for the slightly older generation still wishing to participate. We are linked to Darvel fc where we have a pathway through for boys continuing after under 20s. We have recently asset transfered on a lease our pitch and changing pavilion which we allow other community groups to use. We are currently trying to develop both the pitch and pavilion to be better for all with a new kitchen currently being fitted in pavilion. We work closely with other groups in the area to help where we can and vice versa.

In this period as a Club we have taken over via asset transfer our pitch and pavilion at Jamieson Park and have spent considerable time and efforts getting the pitch to a good standard.

We have purchased equipment so that we can do a lot of the work ourself using the volunteers available to complete the work.

We have upgraded our small sided goals due to influx in number of teams and due to old ones being in a poor state of disrepair.

We have moved to Team Fee Pay who now collect all subs Payments Electronically which has made a massive difference for us and parents seem Happy with it as well.

This has all contributed to a better environment for the players and given a better setup for improved teaching/learning and enjoyment.

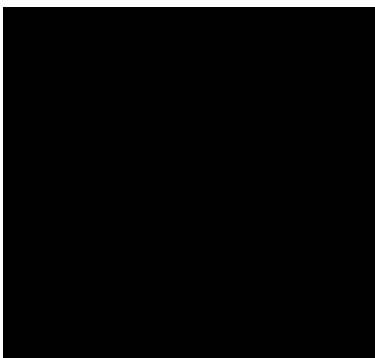
