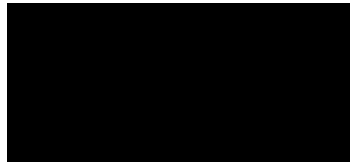

The trustees present their report with the financial statements of the charity for the year ended 31 May 2025.

CONSTITUTION

The Charity is a Scottish Charitable Incorporated Organisation (a SCIO), it has a single tier structure and as such the trustees are the members of the charity.

GOVERNANCE

Overall responsibility for all charitable activities lies with the group members in the committee. Decisions in the trustees are by a simple majority with the chair having a casting vote.

TRUSTEE SELECTION

The trustees are selected from members of the group. There is no formal training but trustees are required, by self study with the materials provided on the OSCR website, to be aware of their responsibilities of the charity.

MAIN ACTIVITIES

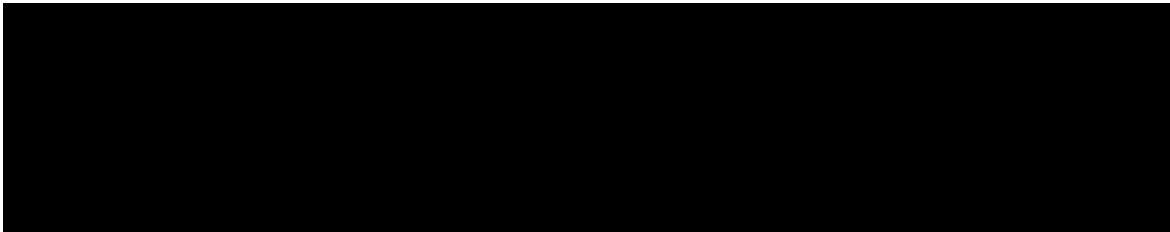
Offering weekly boxing classes & keep fit courses inside the gymnasium or directly within local schools or community halls, attending and holding various boxing events and competitions during the year.


BASIS OF INDEPENDENT EXAMINER'S STATEMENT

1 ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Basis of Accounting

These accounts have been prepared on the Receipts and Payments basis in accordance with the Charities & Trustee Investment (Scotland) Act 2005 and the Charities Accounts (Scotland) Regulations 2006 (as amended).

Donations

Voluntary income is received by the way of donations and gifts and is included in full in the Statement of Receipts & Payments when receivable.

Nature and Purpose of Funds

Unrestricted funds are those that may be used at the discretion of the trustees in furtherance of the objects of the charity. Restricted funds may only be used for specific purposes. Restrictions arise when specified by the donor or when funds are raised for specific purposes.

The charity is not registered for VAT and accordingly costs are shown gross of irrecoverable VAT.
