The charity will continue to support families for up to 2 years following the loss of a child from cancer.

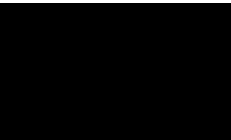

Donations received as at 31 October 2025 total **£42'697**, an increase of £8,629 since last years return. To date the charity has not yet made any purchases. Fundraising for Lily's Lodge continues, the charity is planning to register with larger charity events and encourage our supporters to raise sponsorship on behalf of the charity.

- Dance Events

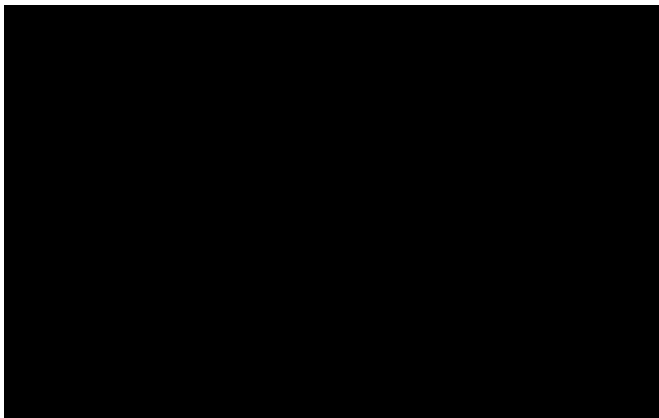
Donated facilities and services:
